The MEA CRA role is ideal if you have a certification in a related allied health profession from an appropriately accredited institution (e.g., nursing licensure) and a minimum of two years of experience in a related role, such as site management, study coordinator, research nurse, etc. If you have a university or college degree, the Clinical Research Assistant is the perfect path to jump-start your career and gain on-the-job experience.
